

Hanaree JEANNIE DIBENEDETTO

Jeanne DiBenedetto (known to all as Ms. D.), is currently our Director of Student Life and Ministry and teaches acting and theatre. She began her career at the Academy of Mount St. Ursula in September of 1999 as a Religion Teacher. Having been involved in Youth and Music Ministry/Performances for over 20 years, she immediately began to organize the retreats, choir and performances.



During Jeannie's 22 years here at AMSU, her role went through some changes. In 2003, Ms. D. became the Producer of our Spring Musicals. A few years later in 2011, she "moved up" from the Youth Ministry office and teaching to provide Administrative support in the area of Student Affairs and Activities. This position includes coordinating Metro cards, Enrichment Days and the School Meals Program for the students. When asked what some of her favorite memories are from her time at AMSU, she found it almost impossible to choose! Some special highlights include: Christmas Masses; Ring Day (especially the ones when it rained); the Musical; International Nights (especially the year of Hurricane Sandy which was put together in four days); and the Junior and Senior Retreats.

Ms. D. would like to thank all the Ursuline Sisters, Administrators, Staff, and Faculty that she has worked with throughout the years for all their support and willingness to help support the the activities. She also thanks all of her students for touching her life in so many ways. Honoree DANIEL HOULIHAN

Daniel Houlihan has been an active member of both the Academy of Mount St. Ursula and the wider Bronx and Westchester communities for decades. Honoree ANNELEN MADIGAN '65 & JOSEPH MURIANA

A native New Yorker, Joe Muriana was both born and raised in Brooklyn, NYC. Joe has been a Bronx resident ever since, for the past half century, attending and then graduating Fordham College in 1975 with a Bachelor of Science degree. After college, and for a period of ten years, Joe worked as a community organizer with the Northwest Bronx



Community and Clergy Coalition (NWBCCC), a grass roots, community-based, ecumenical, umbrella organization, initially sponsored by a group of 12 Catholic Parishes in the Bronx, targeted to work on preserving, developing and revitalizing the aging neighborhoods of the northwest Bronx.

Joe came to AMSU through his wife, Annelen '65 and his connections with Fordham University. He has been important to the recent improvements around the campus and structure of our beloved home. In addition to serving as a Trustee at the Academy of Mount St. Ursula, where he functions as the chair of the Board Facilities Committee. Joe is also on the Executive Committee. He was appointed by Cardinal Dolan as a founding Trustee of the Northwest/South Bronx Regional School Board of the Archdiocese of New York, a network of 10 Catholic elementary schools in the Bronx, where he has served as Chair of the Catholic Identity Committee.

Joe is grateful to his many dear friends, mentors, collaborators, and colleagues who collectively fed, inspired and renewed his spirit over the many years, and the many different periods of his life's episodes. 


