

Attention Students and Families:

Summer School Registration Procedures

It is every student's responsibility to come in to school to get one's report card on Monday, June 25th and to make sure that you sign up for summer school if you find you have failed a class or Regents examination. No excuses!

Registration begins on Friday June 22nd at the various schools so you must be ready to go register if needed.

To register for summer school, you must first come to guidance who will be set up in the faculty area on Monday, June 25th once you have your report card or are told to report there by your teachers or administration. You must then take the paperwork you received from guidance to the Catholic summer school selected by you on the days that the summer school designates for their registration.

Catholic School Summer School is the policy because we know the quality of the programs and we get the results, grades and scores very easily. Please let us (Guidance or Main Office) know right away on June 25th or June 26th which school and which courses your child will be taking.

If you chose for your child to go to public school, you and your child are responsible for handing in the necessary paperwork and getting it to us so your child can get the appropriate credit. We need to know right away on June 25th or June 26th which public school your child is attending.

Online courses are only for non-Regents courses and must be approved by the Guidance Counselors.
