Three department-wide contests will be held:

1. **Pi Memorization Contest**

On Thursday, March 14th, verbally list from memory as many consecutive digits of pi as you can! Contest will be held in the cafeteria during the **Pi Day Celebration at 2 pm** (after our return from Fordham Prep). The first 1000 digits of pi can be found on the back of this sheet. The top three contestants will receive a prize. Last year, Mary Lou DeJesus (class of 2018) beat her own record and recited 1,286 digits and Yumiko Figaro (current sophomore) recited 180 digits.....will anyone be able to beat this????!!!!

2. **Poster Decorating Contest**

Using a standard size poster board (22in by 28in) make an original poster focusing on pi or Albert Einstein (3/14 is also his birthday). Posters are due by **Monday, March 11th**, to your math teachers, so that the posters can be displayed on the second floor

Departmental awards will be given in **two categories**:

1. Most informative about pi or Einstein (history, facts, people associated with).
2. Most creative/artistic using pi or Einstein.

The Math faculty will vote, and top two posters will receive a prize.

3. **Poem/Song**

Write an original poem or song about Pi, Einstein or Concepts in Math. The top two in this Category will receive a prize. Poems/songs are due no later than **Monday, March 11th** to your math teacher.

If selected as a winner, you are welcome to perform your song/poems at our Pi Day Celebration on Thursday, March 14th at 2pm.

OR, just join us for a Pi Day celebration on **Thursday, March 14th at 2 pm in the Cafeteria.**

We will be completing an investigation lesson on Pi!!!!
